LOC Report

In 2025, the POSN Foundation and the Department of Geography, Faculty of Arts, Chulalongkorn University co-hosted the 21st International Geography Olympiad (iGeo 2025) in celebration of the 70th birthday anniversary of Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn. Her Royal Highness was the one who initiated the POSN Foundation's program to select Thai students to participate in iGeo. Thailand first joined the Olympiad in 2015 and has continued to participate every year since.

The competition was held from **26 July to 1 August 2025** at Chulalongkorn University, Bangkok. On **27 July**, Her Royal Highness graciously presided over the Opening Ceremony and delivered the opening address. During the ceremony, Steering Committee members, along with team leaders and students from each participating country, paraded to introduce their national teams before Her Royal Highness.

In the afternoon of the same day, students took the **Written Response Test (WRT)**. On **28 July**, they participated in the **Fieldwork Exercise (FWE)** on Koh Kret, Nonthaburi Province, a cultural tourism destination that is physically an island and highly vulnerable to riverbank erosion and flooding. The **Multimedia Test (MMT)** followed on 29 July, held at the Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center, a fully equipped sound lab designed for multimedia-based examinations.

In addition to the tests, students also took part in a **poster presentation** and two excursion activities. The first excursion was a visit to the **Grand Palace**, while the second was a trip to **Bang Kachao**, often called the "green lung" of Bangkok, where participants experienced the unique local lifestyle. They also engaged in creative workshops such as tie-dye fabric making and perfume crafting.

To further immerse participants in Thai culture, a **Cultural Night** was organized under the theme of a traditional Thai temple fair. Participants wore their national costumes to exchange and celebrate cultural diversity.

The competition concluded with the **Closing Ceremony on 31 July**, where medals were awarded to outstanding participants. In total, 91 medals were presented to 179 students from 47 countries, comprising **16 gold**, **31 silver**, and **44 bronze medals**.
