

List of Acceptable Materials for Students

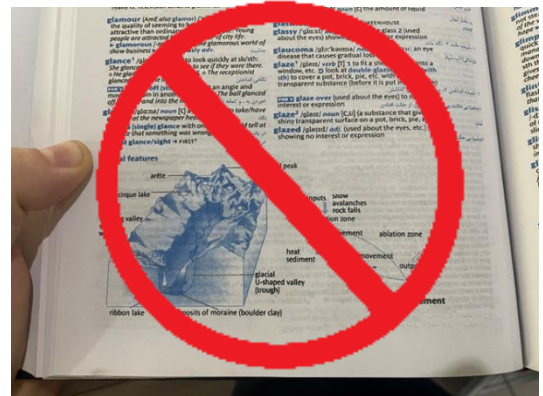
Mobile Phones/Cell Phones

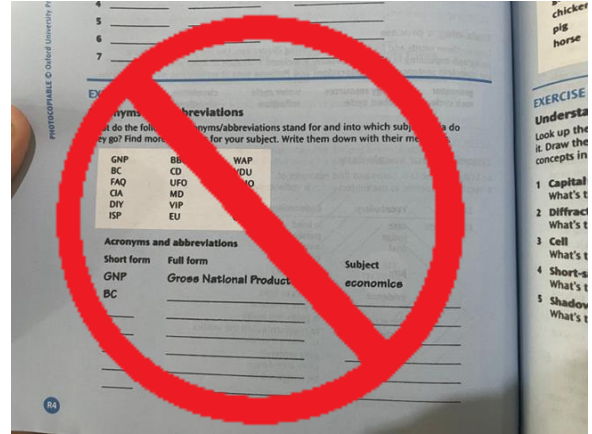
Students will **NOT** be allowed to have their phones at any time during testing, including during the lunch break between FWE 1 and FWE 2. On the day of the FWE, team leaders will need to collect students' phones before the test, and cannot return them until the fieldwork exercise is completed.

- **Dictionaries**

Students who are not educated primarily in English are allowed to bring a bilingual dictionary into all three tests. These should be straight English to native language translation dictionaries with **no definitions, illustrations, maps or diagrams**.

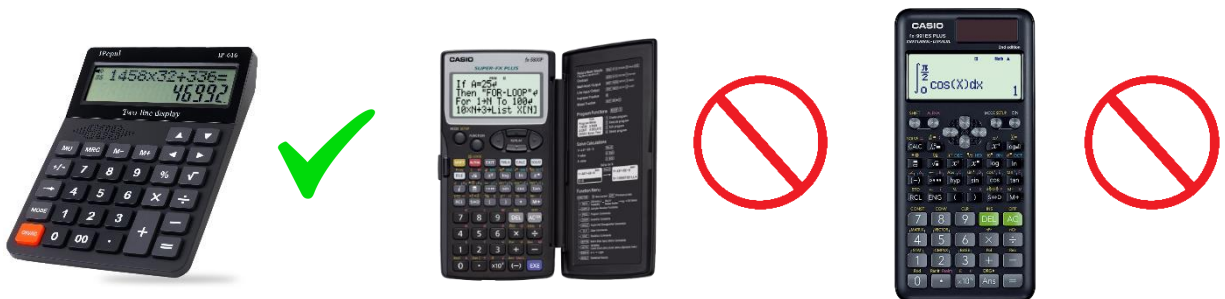


Dictionaries will be checked by members of the Steering Committee prior to the first test and a small sticker will be attached to indicate that the dictionary has been approved for all iGeo tests.

- **Simple calculators**

Any simple calculator can be used for the basic calculations required on the tests.

Scientific or programmable calculators will not be allowed. Prior to the first test, all calculators will be checked and a small sticker will be attached to indicate the calculator has been approved for iGeo use.



- **Watches**

Students will not be allowed to wear watches or devices that connect to the internet in the exam room. There will be clocks in the exam rooms, but if students wish to wear a watch in the exam room, they must be simple analogue or digital watches ie. They ONLY tell time, with no other functions. It is strongly recommended that students have an analogue watch with them for the fieldwork.



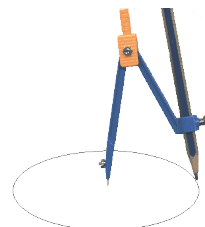
- **Food and Drink**

Students may have a water bottle with them in the MMT, WRT and FWE 2 tests, but no soft drinks, energy drinks or food/snacks will be permitted.

During the FWE 1 test, students may carry a small, noise-free snack with them if they so choose.

- **Other materials:**

- ✓ Pen(s) – blue or black
- ✓ Pencil
- ✓ Eraser
- ✓ Pencil sharpener
- ✓ Coloured pencils/pens
- ✓ Highlighter
- ✓ Ruler(s) – cannot be scale rulers
- ✓ Protractor
- ✓ Compass (for drawing circles, not for determining direction)
- ✓ White Out or Dryliner
- ✓ Pencil case
- ✓ Tissues



- **For FWE:**

- ✓ Analogue watch (see above)
- ✓ Insect repellent
- ✓ Sunscreen
- ✓ Sunglasses
- ✓ Small backpack to carry items during FWE data collection (not allowed in the WRT, MMT or FWE 2)
- ✓ Water bottle and snack (optional)
- ✓ Hat
- ✓ Rain gear
- ✓ Clipboard
- ✓ Plastic cover sheet (for protection from rain)
- ✓ Other tools or materials needed for specific fieldwork tasks will be provided by the Local Organizing Committee.
